Community/Home Connections

- Ask your child about the problem-solving framework they use when they encounter a conflict (Stop it. Name it. Explain it. Ask for Change).
- Try role playing conflict resolution at home with your child.
- Encourage your child/children to use “I” statements to identify and explain their emotions.
